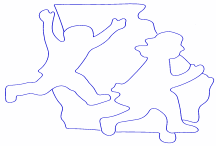

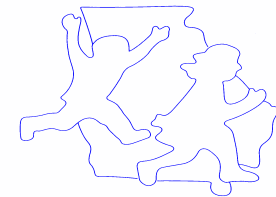

... you need to meet the new Bright from the Start (BFTS) Training Approval System requirements effective January 1, 2008?

... you took the 30-hour TFT and now realize that under the new Training Approval requirements 40-hours of TFT I are part of the requirement to be approved as a Level 1 trainer?

... you don't have 10 hours of training of trainers coursework that qualifies to fill the additional 10-hour requirement?
